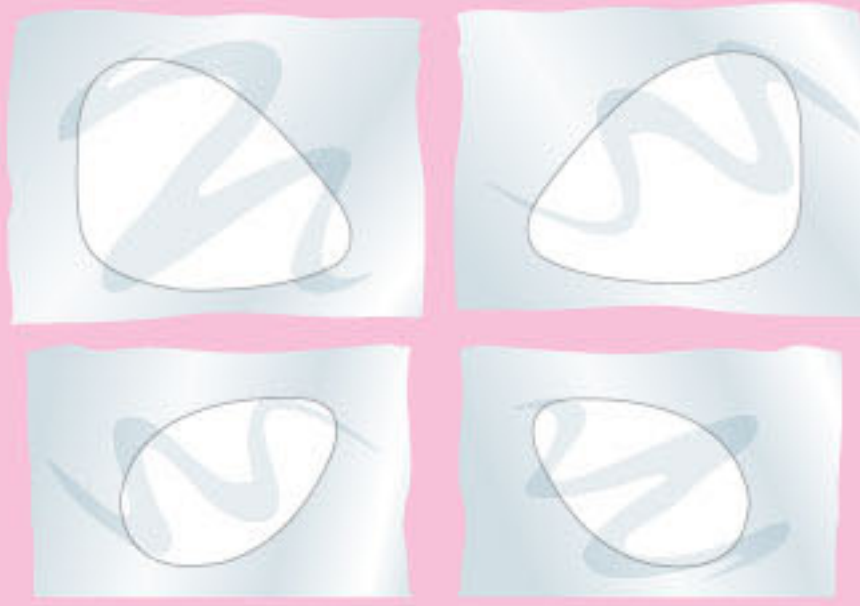


Fairy wings





1. Draw two big and two smaller wings on paper. Cut them out, then lay plastic foodwrap over them.



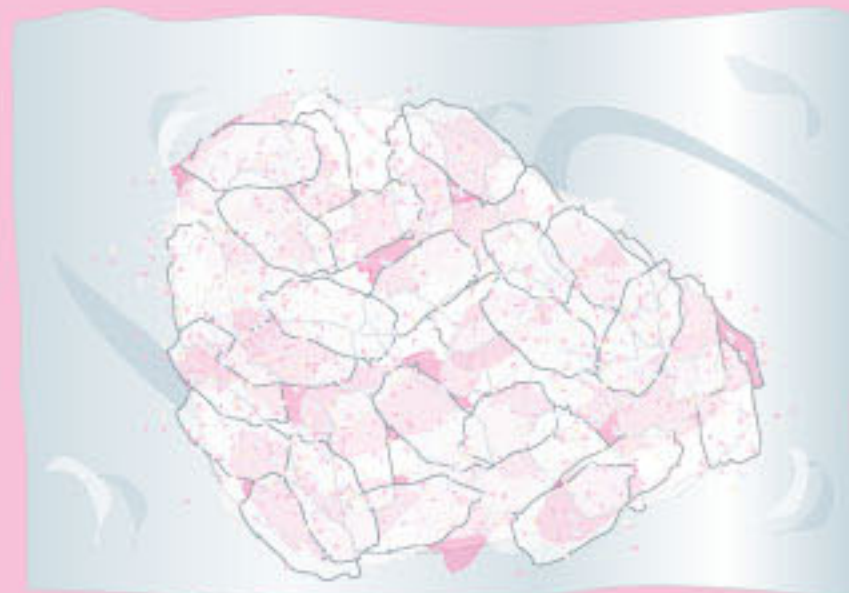
2. Rip up white tissue paper. Overlap lots of pieces on the plastic, covering the wings and their edges.



3. Mix white glue with water to make it runny. Then, brush it over the pieces of tissue paper.



4. Add a layer of ripped pieces of pink tissue paper and glue. Then, add two more white layers.



5. Sprinkle glitter on the wet glue. When it is dry, brush a layer of glue over the top. Let it dry.



6. Peel off the tissue paper. Lay the paper wings on top, draw around them and cut out the shapes.



7. Glue the top parts of the wings onto the bottom parts. Decorate the wings with sequins.



8. Make four holes in a small cardboard rectangle. Thread two long ribbons through the holes.



9. Glue the rectangle onto the back of the wings, with the ribbons sticking out. Let the glue dry.
