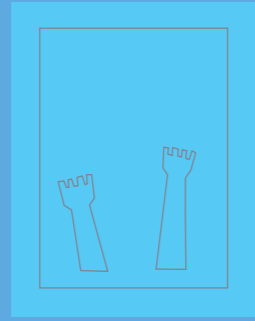
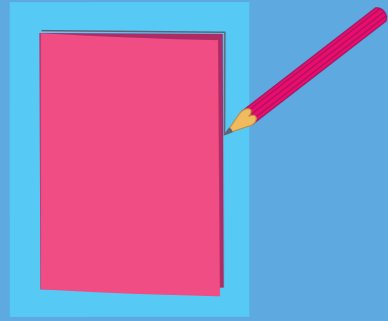
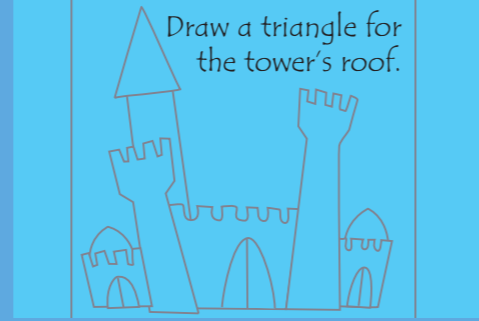


Spooky castle card

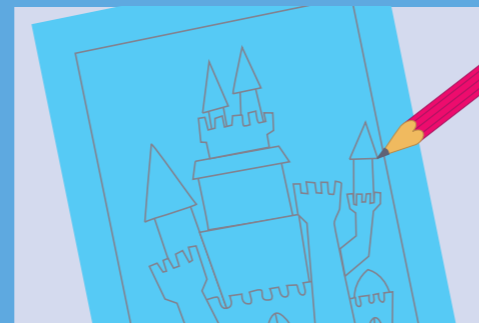


1. Fold a rectangle of thin cardboard in half, with its short ends together. Then, lay it on a piece of thick paper and draw around it.

2. Lift off the folded paper. Then, draw two crooked castle towers near the bottom of the rectangle you have drawn.



3. Draw a big entrance between the towers and a smaller one on each side of them. Add a tower to one side of the entrance, too.



4. Draw a wall above the big entrance. Add roofs and turrets on top. Then, draw another tower to the side of the castle.



5. Draw windows and roof tiles. Then, fill in around the castle with a black felt-tip pen. Fill in any spaces between the towers, too.



Try gluing a path, a tree or bushes onto your card.



You could press on a moon sticker from the sticker pages, too.



6. Using a silver pen, carefully draw over all the pencil lines. Then, cut around the edge of the black border, like this.



7. With the fold at the top, draw a line near the top of the folded paper. Fill in the rectangle above the line with the black pen.



8. Glue the bottom of the castle onto the black rectangle. Then, draw lots of ovals for a pebbly path below the castle.
