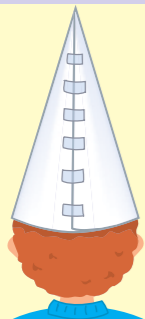
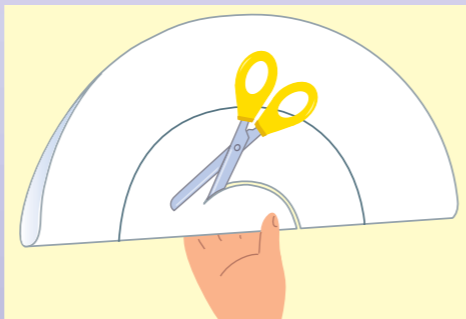
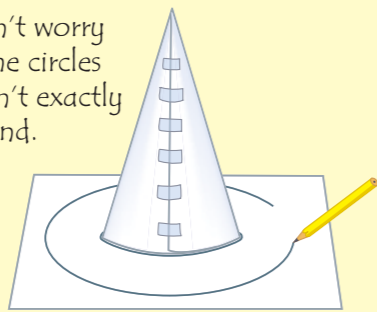


Starry wizard's hat

Tape the cone in several places.



Don't worry if the circles aren't exactly round.



Hold the layers together as you cut.

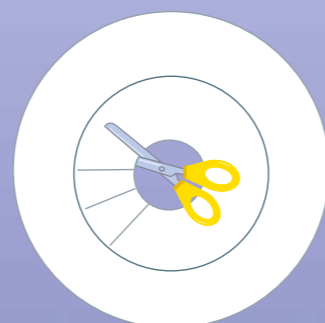
1. Cut a half circle from a large piece of thick paper. Get someone to bend it into a cone around your head, then tape it together.

2. To make the brim, put the cone on another piece of paper. Draw around the cone. Then, draw a bigger circle around the outside.

3. Cut out the big circle. Bend it in half and hold it in the middle. Then, carefully cut a small half circle out of the middle.

6. To decorate the hat, fold a small piece of thick paper in half. Draw half a star against the fold, then cut it out. Open out the stencil.

To decorate your hat like this one, use two stencils and two shades of paint.

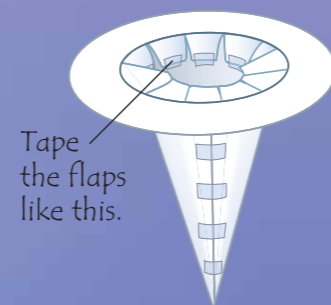


4. Flatten the paper again. Then, make about 10 cuts from the small circle out to the pencil line, but don't cut over the line.

Print about 20 stars.



7. Lay the stencil on a large piece of tissue paper. Dip a sponge into thick paint and dab it all over the stencil. Then, print lots more stars.



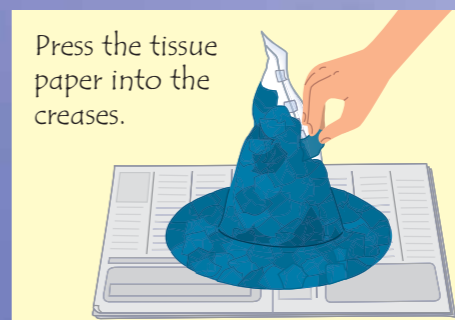
Tape the flaps like this.

5. Lay the brim on top of the open end of the cone. Then, bend each flap down and tape it inside the cone, to secure the brim.



8. While the paint dries, gently squash the cone of the hat with your hands to make it crooked. Bend the brim a little, too.

Press the tissue paper into the creases.



9. Rip lots of pieces from plain tissue paper. Brush white glue onto the hat, then press pieces of tissue paper all over it.

Try not to glue the stars over each other.



10. When the stars are dry, carefully rip around them. Glue them all over the hat, then leave the glue to dry completely.
