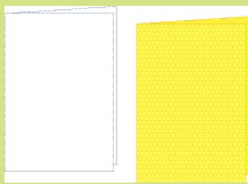


Pop-up monster card

1. Cut two rectangles of paper the same size, one white and one yellow. Fold them both in half, with the short ends together.

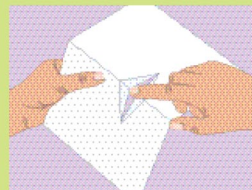
Make the cut about two thirds of the way down the fold.



2. Make a cut into the fold in the white rectangle, for the monster's mouth. Fold back the paper on each side of the cut, like this.

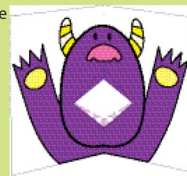


3. Turn the card over and fold the flaps back on themselves. Then, unfold the flaps, so that the card lies flat again.



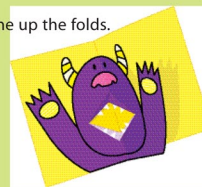
4. Open the card a little, then push the flaps down through the fold, like this. Close the card and press the folds to flatten them.

Glue the teeth to the back of the flaps.



5. Open the card. Draw a monster around the mouth and fill it in with felt-tip pens. Then, cut teeth from paper and glue them on.

Line up the folds.



6. Cut around the monster. Then, spread glue all over the back of it, except for the mouth. Press it onto the yellow rectangle.

Write a message around your monster or on the back of the card.

If you make the cut a third of the way down the fold in step 2, you can draw a whole monster.



You could make a monster with lots of teeth.
