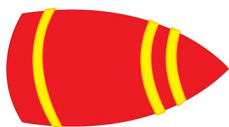
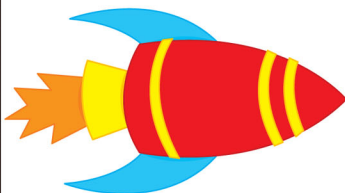


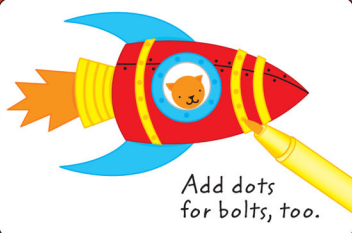
Rocket Collage



1. Draw the main part of the rocket on a piece of red paper. Cut it out and glue it onto another piece of paper. Then, cut out curved strips and glue them on, too.



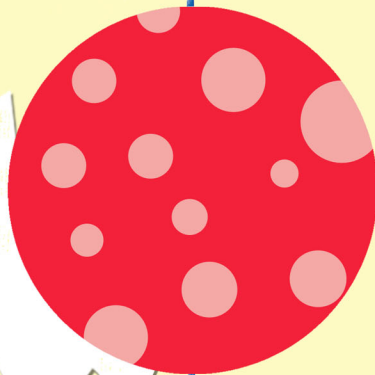
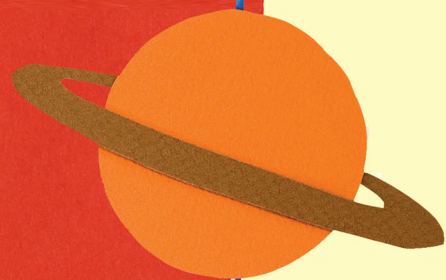
2. Cut a shape for a booster at the back of the rocket and some flames and glue them on. Cut out two fins and glue them onto the sides of the rocket.



Add dots for bolts, too.

3. Cut out two circles for a window, making one smaller than the other. Glue them on. Then, use felt-tip pens to draw an 'astronaut' in the window and a line on the rocket.

You could use the rocket you have made to make a space mobile. Cut a long piece of string, lay your rocket face down then lay the string on top. Press a little piece of sticky tape down to secure the rocket. Now add lots of other things that you might find in space such as stars, planets or even an astronaut.
