

Coloured pencil drawing

For this project, you can use normal coloured pencils or water-soluble pencils without any water. This style of drawing is often used for fashion designs, so have a look through some fashion magazines for some ideas and different faces to draw.



1. Draw an oval in light blue pencil. Don't press too hard. Then, add the features. Try drawing the irises to the right, so the eyes look sideways.

The highlights in the eyes were left uncoloured.

You can add touches of pink on the cheeks.

Use a strong colour on the lips to look like lipstick.



2. Draw the hair in light blue. Draw round the sides of the face and one side of the nose in brown. Add the eyebrows.



3. Sharpen the brown pencil and draw dark lines along the top of the eyes. Draw in the irises and pupils with sharp pencils, too.



4. Lightly shade the face in light brown. Add some darker brown down one side of the face and under the chin.



5. Shade the lips in red. Add brown on the top lip, to make it darker. Fill in the hair with long, flowing pencil lines.
